To ensure that each activity is developmentally appropriate and engaging, Westlink International School organizes its Extra-Curricular Activities (ECAs) into the following grade-level groupings:

Group	Grade Level	Targets
Lower Primary	Intro to Grade 1	Designed for our youngest learners, this group focuses on foundational skills, creativity, and play-based learning. Activities are carefully selected to support social-emotional development, motor coordination, and curiosity.
Middle Primary	Grade 2 to 3	At this stage, students are beginning to refine their interests and develop more structured skills. ECAs for this group offer a balance of fun, discovery, and early skill-building across various domains such as the arts, sports, and STEM.
Upper Primary	Grade 4 to 5	Students in this group are ready for more advanced exploration of their interests. Activities provide opportunities to deepen existing skills, take on leadership roles, and engage in more collaborative and competitive settings.
Secondary	Grade 6 to 9	Students in this group are ready for more advanced exploration of their interests. Activities provide opportunities to deepen existing skills, take on leadership roles, and engage in more collaborative and competitive settings.
