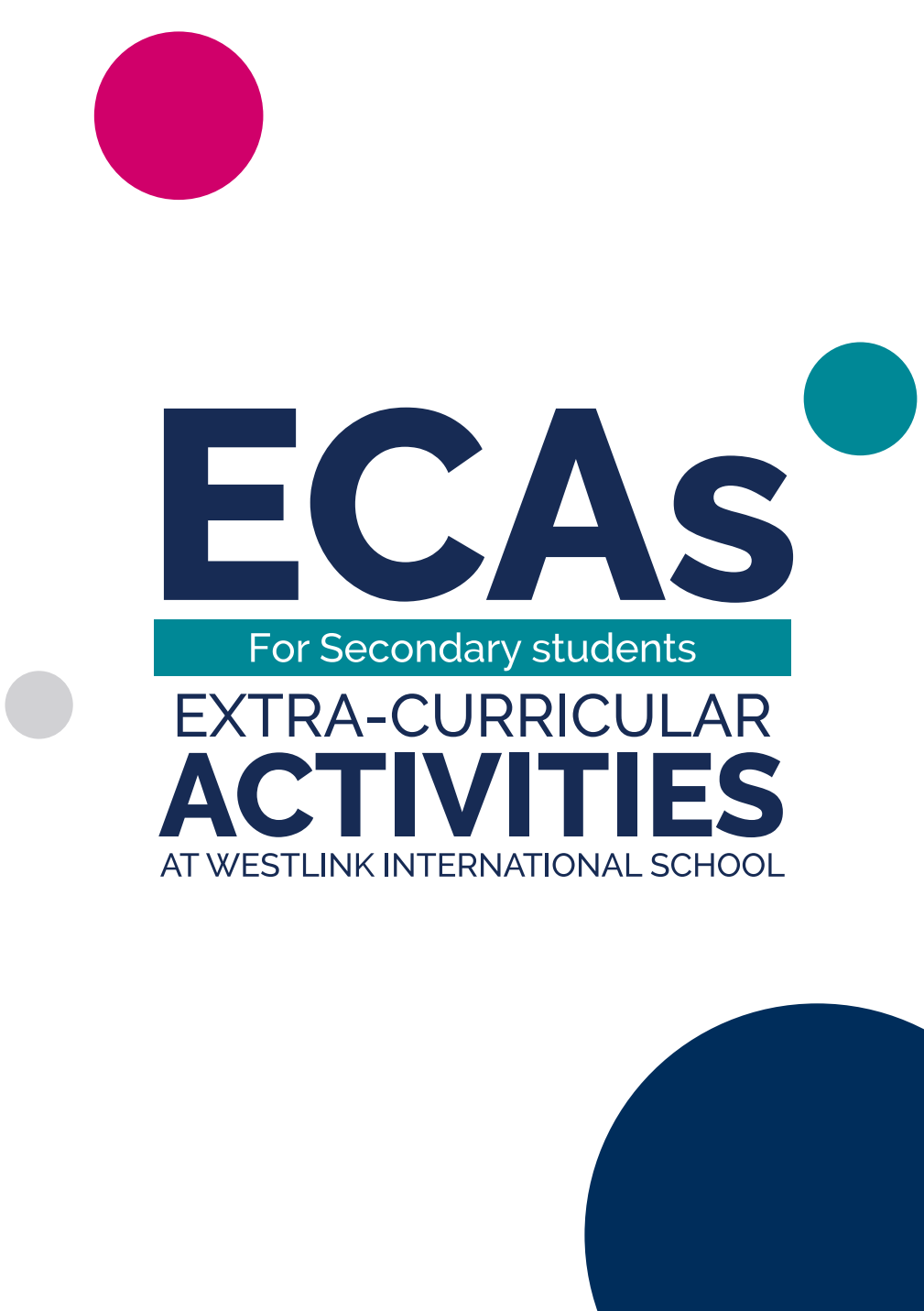

ISP CHANGEMAKERS: SUSTAINABLE CAMPUS



ISP Changemakers: Sustainable Campus is a programme for students aged 4-18 where learners play a powerful role in designing and launching their own project to make their school more sustainable. All Sustainable Campus projects focus on one or more of the programme's core sustainability themes:

- Energy
- Water
- Waste
- Green spaces & biodiversity
- Food
- Transport

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** Know key concepts related to sustainability, carbon footprints, and how different systems work together.
- **Skills:** Use systems-thinking to explore how different parts of the school are connected, and involve others so that change is shared, supported, and sustainable.
- **Understanding:** Understand why sustainability matters and how small actions can lead to meaningful impact within their school community.
- **Confidence:** Feel confident to speak up about sustainability, share their ideas with others, and take practical steps to make their school more environmentally friendly.



ISP CHANGEMAKERS: SOCIAL IMPACT



ISP Changemakers: Social Impact is a programme where learners work with trusted non-profit organisations to help reduce barriers to education. Students take the lead in exploring the issues, choosing the organisation they want to support and designing a project that directly contributes to that organisation's mission. Their projects may focus on raising awareness, fundraising or taking part in volunteering activities, depending on what each organisation needs and what is possible in their school context.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** Know what a Theory of Change is and why some children and young people face barriers to education.
- **Skills:** Use a Theory of Change to plan and implement a project, and work collaboratively to create social impact.
- **Understanding:** Understand how planning, teamwork and clear goals help create change.
- **Confidence:** Feel confident leading their project, making decisions and explaining how their actions contribute to real social impact.



ISP CHANGEMAKERS: IDEAS FOR ACTION



ISP Changemakers: Ideas for Action is a programme for students aged 4-18 where learners identify a local issue that matters to them and design a project to address it. Projects can focus on any theme connected to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), including wellbeing, inclusion, safety, equality or community support.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** Know what the SDGs are and how they connect to local issues they care about.
- **Skills:** Explore problems, develop ideas, and lead a project that makes a difference.
- **Understanding:** Recognise they can lead change by improving their ideas over time.
- **Confidence:** Feel confident to share their ideas and lead a project.



ILOS REGIONAL MUN



ISP MUN offers students an authentic global diplomacy experience that strengthens their Life Competencies in meaningful ways. As students research international issues, analyse diverse perspectives, and present evidence-based arguments, they deepen their critical thinking, creativity, and curiosity. Representing a country builds global competencies by encouraging responsible citizenship, informed action, and intercultural understanding.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** Know about international relations, diplomacy, geography, history and current political affairs.
- **Skills:** Be able to use and apply research, writing and public speaking skills.
- **Understanding:** Develop my understanding of conflict resolution and effective tools to engage in multicultural contexts.
- **Confidence:** Grow my confidence in debating with students in international contexts.

ILOS ARTISTS - JUNIOR

ISP Artists Junior ignites students' curiosity and creativity with fresh new ideas for inspiration! There are two Editions per year, each with a different, exciting theme. There is no minimum or maximum number of participants.

This hands-on programme encourages students' artistic development with fun and interesting guided activities in both 2D and 3D media. There are opportunities for students to learn about different countries and cultures, via shared activities with other ISP schools.

Students' artwork will be shared via in-school and regional exhibitions, as well as selected pieces being curated in the ISP Virtual Gallery for public viewing.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** Know about several different artists, artistic movements and creative expression.
- **Skills:** Be able to use artistic techniques and media to express themselves.
- **Understanding:** Develop their understanding of their own thoughts, feelings and perspectives, and how to represent these through art.
- **Confidence:** Develop confidence in their creative and technical abilities.

ILOS ARTISTS - SENIOR

ISP Artists - Senior is a future-ready creative learning programme developed for students aged 11-18 in collaboration with the University of the Arts London (UAL), one of the world's leading arts institutions. Designed to help students understand that creativity is not simply an innate talent but a skill that can be developed through exploration, experimentation, reflection, and practice, the programme provides authentic creative learning experiences that encourage learners to investigate how ideas are communicated visually and how innovation emerges through the combination of different concepts, influences, and perspectives.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** I know key creative thinking, visual communication, and user-centred design principles used to develop innovative and accessible solutions.
- **Skill:** I can apply creative and UX design techniques, including visual storytelling, ideation, research, sketching, prototyping, and presentation, to develop and communicate design concepts.
- **Understanding:** I understand how creativity, experimentation, usability, accessibility, and user needs influence the design and development of effective products and experiences.
- **Confidence:** I can demonstrate confidence in generating, refining, and presenting creative ideas and design solutions through collaborative and independent practice.

ILOS FILMMAKERS

The ISP Filmmakers Programme gives students a hands-on introduction to filmmaking as they plan, shoot, act, edit, and promote their own productions. While learning, students will strengthen their key Life Competency skills: Socio-emotional understanding through listening and shared decision making, communication through sharing ideas and awareness of different styles of messaging, collaboration working as part of a film crew with shared responsibilities, and creativity through imaginative problem solving and exploring multiple different possibilities for the films direction, alongside digital literacy through regular use of digital tools and media across the filmmaking process.

Activity Targets

- **Knowledge:** *Know a range of technical skills needed for filmmaking.*
- **Skills:** *To work and adapt as part of a team in various roles.*
- **Understanding:** *The importance of planning and organization to finalize a project successfully.*

STUDY GROUP

The Study Group Program for Secondary students provides a structured environment for independent study, homework completion, and academic support. Students are encouraged to strengthen subject knowledge, improve time management, and develop effective study habits through focused learning sessions, peer collaboration, and teacher guidance in a productive and supportive setting.

Activity Targets

- **Review and strengthen understanding of Science concepts** through guided study sessions.
- **Complete homework and revise lessons independently and collaboratively.**
- **Improve critical thinking and problem-solving skills.**
- **Develop effective study habits and time management.**
- **Build confidence by participating actively in peer discussions and teacher-guided learning.**

Amount per session: VND 50.000



EAL SUPPORT (Selected Students only)

EAL Support provides targeted English language development for selected secondary students. Through structured and engaging activities, students strengthen academic vocabulary, communication, reading, writing, and comprehension skills.

Activity Targets

- **Academic Communication:** *Develop confidence in speaking, listening, discussions, presentations, and classroom communication using appropriate academic English.*
- **Literacy Development:** *Strengthen reading comprehension, vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, and writing skills across different academic contexts.*
- **Classroom Success:** *Develop language strategies for understanding instructions, completing assignments, expressing ideas clearly, and participating effectively in secondary school learning.*



STEM: THE CURIOSITY HUB

STEM: Curiosity Hub is a hands-on space where students explore, question, experiment and create. From exciting science experiments and mathematical puzzles to game design, coding and STEM challenges, students will turn curiosity into action. The ECA encourages creative thinking, collaboration, problem-solving and the confidence to test ideas, learn and try again.

Activity Targets

- Explore through fun, hands-on STEM experiments.
- Solve intriguing maths and logic puzzles.
- Create simple games and digital projects.
- Take on creative STEM challenges.



HANDMADE BRACELET

Students will create their own handmade bracelets using colorful beads, strings, and simple patterns. They can choose colors and designs that reflect their personality or interests. The activity encourages students to enjoy a creative, hands-on experience while connecting with others and proudly wearing or sharing their handmade bracelets.

Activity Targets

- Develop creativity and imagination.
- Improve fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.
- Encourage self-expression through colors and designs.
- Build patience and concentration.
- Develop confidence by completing a handmade project.
- Encourage positive social interaction through sharing ideas and creating together.
- Promote enjoyment of hands-on creative activities.

Amount per session: VND 80.000



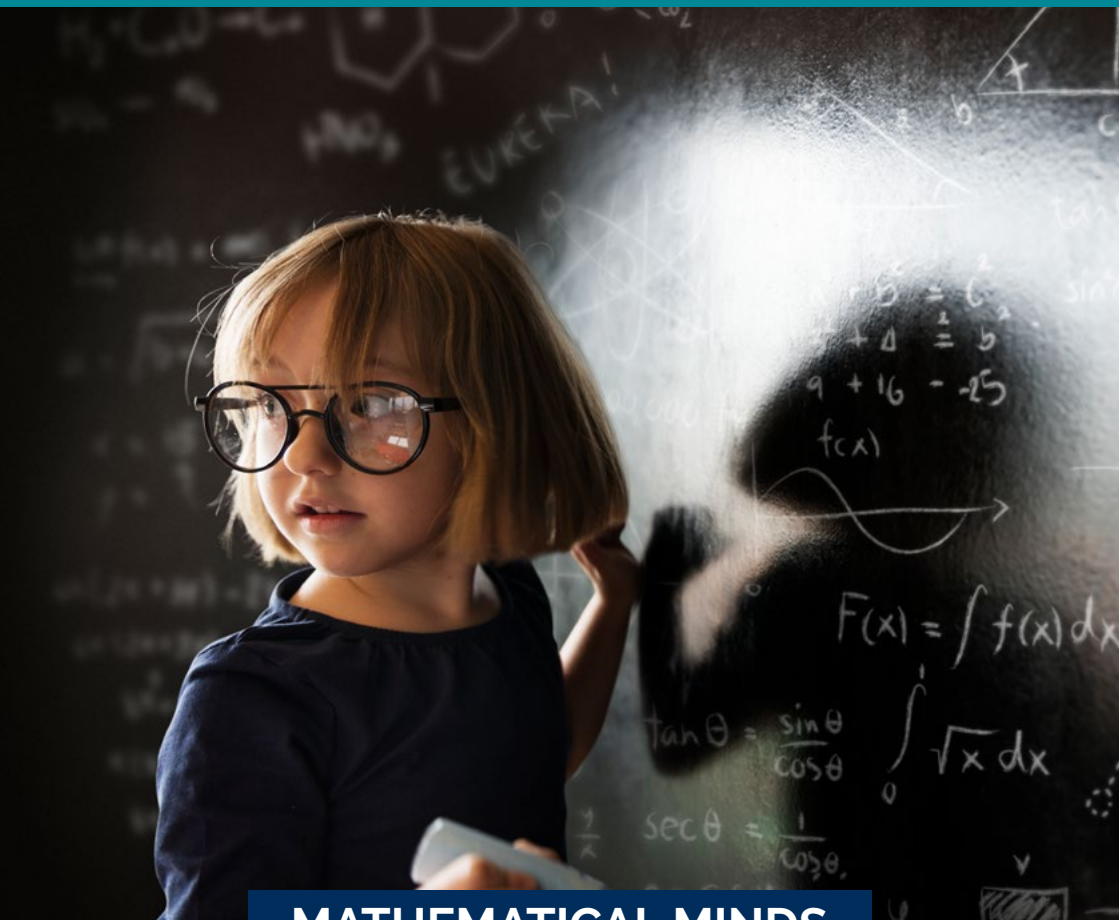
CREATIVE ARTS & CRAFTS ECA

Amount per session: VND 80.000



MATHEMATICAL MINDS

is an engaging academic club designed specifically for Vietnamese students. It provides opportunities for students to strengthen mathematical knowledge, develop logical thinking, and explore challenging problems through games, discussions, and real-life applications. The club encourages curiosity, creativity, collaboration, and confidence in a supportive and interactive learning environment.

Activity Targets

- Strengthen students' core mathematical knowledge and skills.
- Support students in reviewing and consolidating classroom learning.
- Develop logical, critical, and creative thinking.
- Encourage problem-solving through challenging and real-life tasks.
- Build confidence in using mathematics.
- Promote collaboration, discussion, and independent learning.

Activity Targets

- **Structured & Mandala:** Repetitive, symmetrical patterns for calm and focus.
- **Nature & Floral:** Flowers, plants, landscapes, and natural forms.
- **Geometric & Abstract:** Shapes, lines, grids, and free-flowing designs.
- **Characters & Symbols:** Icons, and visual representations.
- **Typography & Patterns:** Creative lettering, words, textures, and repeated motifs.
- **Surreal & Imaginative:** Dreamlike combinations and creative storytelling.
- **Mind-Mapping:** Visual connections between designs and ideas.

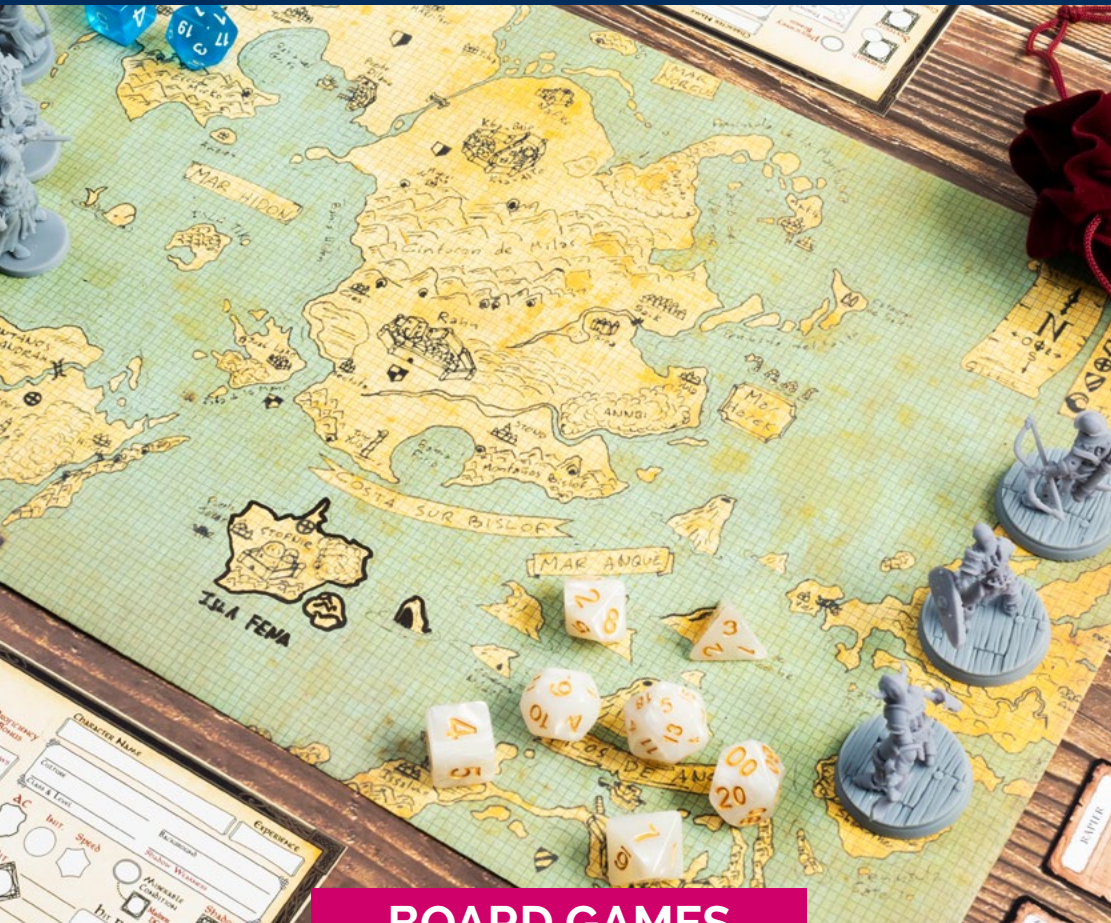
VIETNAMESE LITERATURE

BOARD GAMES

Activity Targets

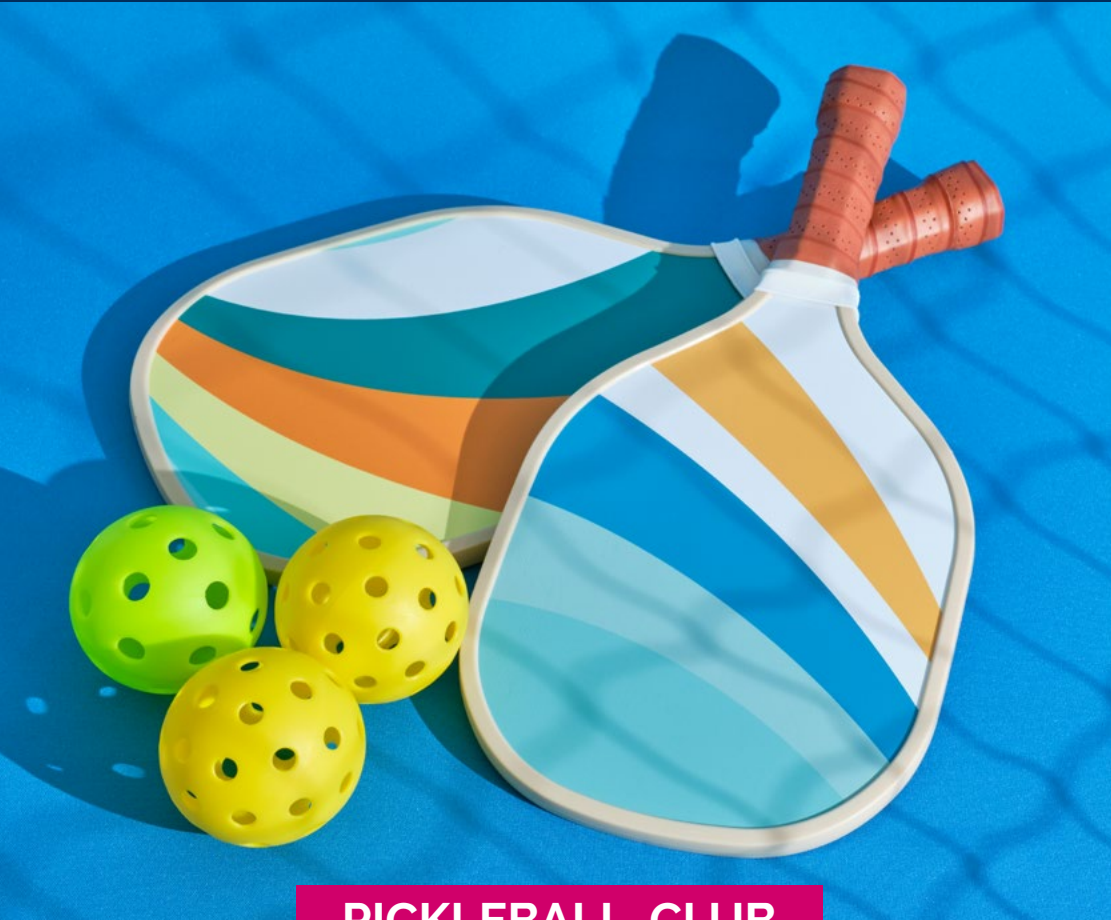
EAL SUPPORT (Selected Students only)

A training-focused team for boys developing their volleyball skills, teamwork, game understanding, and confidence. Players will build fundamental techniques while preparing for future competitive opportunities.

Activity Targets

- Develop fundamental volleyball skills and techniques.
- Build teamwork, communication, and game understanding.
- Develop confidence and prepare for competitive play.

VIETNAMESE INSTRUMENT

This programme introduces students to the beauty of Vietnamese traditional music through two iconic instruments: the Vietnamese Bamboo Xylophone (Đàn Tranh) and the Vietnamese Zither (Đàn Trung). Students will learn techniques, traditional and international music, and cultural stories from Europe to Asia while developing creativity, hand-eye coordination, teamwork, and confidence through performance activities.

Activity Targets

- Develop proper technique, instrument care, and stage presence.
- Connect with peers across cultures through the universal language of music.
- Discover their own personal artistic identity through musical exploration.

Amount per session: VND 250.000



FOOTBALL

Football ECA offers a fun, active, and safe environment where primary students can truly enjoy the game. Guided by supportive coaches, sessions combine basic skill practices with friendly games that teach teamwork, fair play, and sportsmanship. The program naturally helps children develop essential physical fitness, including speed, agility, and endurance. This club is ideal for energetic students who love running and playing in open spaces, providing a positive experience with organized sports and promoting a healthy lifestyle.

Activity Targets

- Mastering core football skills (dribbling, passing, receiving, and shooting) through structured and thematic technical drills.
- Developing foundational tactical awareness, covering basic principles of attack, defense, and transitions via competitive mini-games.
- Fostering essential team dynamics, collective coordination, and sportsmanship through small-sided games and organized matches.

Amount per session: VND 250.000



TAEKWONDO

Taekwondo ECA offers a structured, non-contact environment focused on self-discipline, focus, and emotional regulation. Rather than combat or sparring, each session guides students through the beauty of martial arts mechanics, including blocking, punching, and kicking techniques. The program naturally enhances exceptional core fitness, explosive power, and full-body control. It is perfectly designed for detail-oriented children who enjoy personal mastery and steady self-improvement, helping them build inner confidence, practice active listening, and develop deep respect for themselves and others.

Activity Targets

- Learning foundational martial arts mechanics - including essential blocks, punches, kicks, and safe rolling techniques for injury prevention.
- Combining individual movements into sharp, energetic technical sequences with a focus on accuracy, balance, and rhythm.
- Cultivating lifelong habits of discipline, patience, and mutual respect through traditional martial arts etiquette and collaborative group activities.

Amount per session: VND 250.000



BASKETBALL

Basketball ECA brings an exciting, fast-paced rhythm that keeps primary students energized and engaged. Led by supportive coaches, each session introduces fundamental techniques through cooperative drills and friendly play, ensuring a safe environment centered on teamwork and mutual respect. This program naturally sharpens hand-eye coordination, explosive power, and quick reflexes.
