Middle Years Programme (MYP)

(Grades 6-10)



The IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) is designed for students aged 11 to 16. It provides a framework of learning that emphasizes intellectual challenge and encourages connections between studies in traditional subjects and the real world.

The MYP focuses on "learning how to learn" through the systematic development of approaches to learning (ATL) skills for communication, collaboration, organization, self-management, reflection, research, informational literacy, media literacy, creative and critical thinking, and transfer of learning. It also fosters intercultural understanding and global engagement —essential qualities for young people today.

MOET Replacement Curriculum (MRC) (Grade 6-9)

Our MRC blends the curriculum issued by the Vietnamese Ministry of Education and Training (MOET) with the US curriculum, as well as a student-centered teaching approach that focuses on cultivating English acquisition, problem-solving, critical thinking, innovation, and collaboration skills.

We ensure that students maintain a strong connection to Vietnamese culture and traditions through dedicated classes and activities, including Vietnamese literature, history lessons, and cultural festivals. These activities not only enhance students' understanding and appreciation of their heritage but also promote a sense of pride and identity.

At the end of Grade 9, students will transfer to the International Program and undertake a specially devised preparation year for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP).









English as an Additional Language (EAL) Program

The EAL Program at Westlink enhances language proficiency, supporting both academic success and social integration. By celebrating multilingualism and fostering an inclusive environment, the program helps students build confidence and a strong sense of belonging.

the EAL Program implements Individual Language Plan (ILP) that is collaboratively developed by classroom teachers and the

EAL team. The personalised plan focuses on the specific language goals and priorities for each learner, guiding both in-class and out-ofclass interventions. Additionally, the program utilizes Flash Academy, a platform based on The Bell Foundation's English Proficiency assessment tool, which categorizes students To address the unique needs of each student, into five proficiency bands (A to E). This targeted approach allows for personalized support, ensuring that every student progresses in their language learning journey.
